## SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

### ARTICLE 1 ORGANIZATION

The KREM New Years Day Cycling Classic is organized by Krem Radio under the regulations of the International Cycling Union and the Belize Cycling Association. It is to be held on 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2012. The Open Elite race will start at the Santa Elena Border at 9:00 a.m. The Woman/Masters 4/5 and Junior will start in front of the Town Hall in Orange Walk Town at 9:30 and 9:35 a.m. respectively.

### ARTICLE 2 TYPE OF EVENT

The event is open to athletes of the (male and woman) Categories. The event is entered on the BCA calendar.

The event is registered as a class 2 event. In conformity with the UCI rules, points are awarded as follows:

### ARTICLE 3 PARTICIPATION

This event is open to minimum of 4 and maximum of 10 riders' per each team.

### ARTICLE 4 RACE HEADQUARTERS

Team representatives are requested to submit their Titular List of Starters by Friday, December 23<sup>rd</sup> and reconfirm their starters at the Technical Meeting which will be held on Thursday, December 29<sup>th</sup>, 2011 at a venue to be announced later starting at 7:00 p.m. Yearly permanent race numbers and other paraphernalia will also be issued at that time.

Race Headquarters on the arrival site shall be open at 7 a.m. and located at the Mile 92, Corozal Free Zone, for the Male Elite and Orange Walk Town Hall for the Women/Masters 4/5/Junior Male.

### ARTICLE 5 RADIO TOUR

Race information will be broadcast on the following frequency: 89.5 on the FM dial for the "Male Open Event" and hand held Radios for both the "Women Open/M/Masters Cat 4 & 5" and "M/Junior/Youth".

### ARTICLE 6 NEUTRAL TECHNICAL SUPPORTS

The technical support service will be handled by Belize Cycling Association (for Open Male and Women & Masters Cat 4/5's). Driver: Bruce Vergo – Driver and Mechanic Cleon August will be assigned for the Open event and Mr. Sheffield Eck, Driver and Mr. Burgess will assist the Women and M/Masters 4/5's. The neutral support is taken care of by means of 1 only pickup truck providing spare wheels and water for refreshment.

### ARTICLE 7 FINISHING TIME LIMITS.

Any rider finishing in a time exceeding that of the winner by more than 30 minutes shall not be placed.

All Junior and or Youth riders concerned shall, in accordance with their placing and classifications shall present themselves with their bicycles immediately after crossing the finishing line (at the finished Line) in an effort to conduct their bike gearing verification.

A grand total of \$8675.00 will be awarded in prize money at the event. Prizes will be awarded within 90 days maximum from the official completion of the event.

**ARTICLE 9 AWARDS CEREMONY**

**1.2.112** All riders concerned shall, in accordance with their placing, classifications and performances, participate in official ceremonies such as the presentation of jerseys, bouquets or medals, laps of honor, Press conference and the like.

**1.2.113** Unless otherwise stated, riders shall appear at official ceremonies wearing competition clothing.

In accordance with article 1.2.112 of the UCI rules, the following riders **must** attend the official awards ceremony:

- The first 3 of each category
  - Men Over all Classification
  - Men Juniors
  - Women Over All
  - Men Masters Category 4 & 5, and
- The winners of the station prizes.

The riders will present themselves at the podium in a time limit of maximum 45 minutes after crossing the finish line.

#### **ARTICLE 10 ANTIDOPING**

The NADO anti-doping regulations are entirely applicable to the event. The Anti-doping tests will take place the National Sports Council Conference Room, St. Jude Street, Belize City. \*\*\*Blood testing will be administered.

The **Anti-Doping Panel** will inform the teams of persons to be tested. Each person to be tested needs one (1) representative to accompany them in the specimen booth. All riders who are summoned to be tested must present themselves at the specimen booth (30) thirty minutes after the completion of the event.

**Failure to comply will result in a NON-NEGATIVE test.**

#### **ARTICLE 11 PENALTIES**

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable. (For other events)
